INTRODUCTION




PROOFS, PHOTOS AND QUESTIONS


Some scientists took photographs in the lake. The photos show an animal that is almost as big as a school bus. The beast has a wide body, fins, a skinny neck and a tail.




(Here is shown how easily the human eye may be fooled into thinking it sees an unfamiliar monster.) ►



(This is the first photo of the Loch Ness sea serpent whose head and neck are above the water.)


▼ (Below, white arrow points to curved fin of killer whale which is out of the water.)
